Organisational

Nominees need to:

- Identify and illustrate the design, development and implementation of the particular program, including evidence of Best Practice implementation
- Identify and illustrate the level of support, feedback and involvement by the community for which the particular program is designed
- Identify people or organisations from outside of the target community who have recognised the particular program for its excellence in service and meeting the specific needs of the community it serves.

All nominations should clearly illustrate some or all of the Catholic Social Teaching on which the values of Catholic Welfare Australia and its Member Organisations are based including: The Dignity of the Human Person; Preferential Option for the Poor; Solidarity; Common Good; and/or Distributive Justice

Award for Most Innovative Program *The Norma Parker Award*

Nominees need to:
